Should any tree/shrub bought at W&W Nursery and Landscaping die within one year of the purchase, we will reimburse 50% of the purchase price towards a replacement plant of your choosing. The reimbursement will be issued as an in-store credit that can be used for one year from original date of purchase provided that:

- The dead plant is returned for inspection at the time a claim for replacement is made. If the plant is too large to return, extensive photos of the plant, area of concern, and root zone will suffice. This is the only time photographs will be acceptable as proof of plant death.
- Reasonable horticultural practices were used by the customer.
- The original printed cash register receipt, or invoice, accompanies the returned plant.

WARRANTY NOTES & EXCEPTIONS

- No warranty is given on any sale, final sale, discounted items, annuals, perennials, houseplants, herbs, vegetables, fruit trees & fruit shrubs, or trees with a caliper of 4" or larger.
- No warranty on items purchased with a landscaper, or contractor discount
- No additional warranty will be provided for replacement items
- Any plant that is up to 30% dead will not be warrantied. With proper care, the plant should recover.
- If any plant item dies and we also had issues with the same stock at the nursery, a replacement plant of the same species, size, and value will be offered at no cost at the discretion of management and is subject to current availability. If unavailable, the purchase amount can be refunded, or turned into store credit which is decided upon by the customer.
- W&W Nursery is not responsible for any labor costs, delivery fees, or any other costs incurred in planting or removal of any/all materials. We are also not responsible for damage done by animals (girdling), insects, disease, or weather conditions; generally things that we have no control over. - Any bulk product that has been over-ordered will not be picked up or reimbursed
- Delivery charges are non-refundable on replacement items. If your replacement item needs to be delivered, another delivery charge will be required by the customer
- Any and all claims must be made within 24 hours of delivery and before bulk product, hard goods, or plant materials has been inserted into the landscape
- Per NYS law, W&W Nursery and Landscaping is not allowed to dump any product on streets or any other municipal property. Please do not ask

TO OUR CUSTOMERS

All nursery stock shall meet A.N.L.A. (American Nursery and Landscape Association) standards and is in the best quality we can offer at the time of sale. Acceptance of nursery stock at the time of sale is proof of good health. All nursery stock is inspected by the Department of Agriculture and Markets.

All inventory is used to daily irrigation in our yard and it is of the utmost importance that you, our customer, continue these watering practices for the plants until it has been planted in the ground and has begun to acclimate. W&W Nursery and Landscaping, Inc. strives to do our part in providing good, quality nursery stock and we ask our customers to continue with these practices and do your part to ensure that your living investment continues to thrive.

We care about our customers and have detailed planting instructions available at the time of sale for the benefit of the purchaser during the installation process. If you do not receive one, please ask!

PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) For well-drained soils, dig the hole 1.5-2 times as wide and the same depth as the rootball. Fill in the bottom 3'' with a mixture of 1/3 topsoil, 1/3 of your soil, and 1/3 of compost. (Rue of Thirds)
- 2) For poorly-draining soils, plant the tree or shrub higher generally 1/2 2/3 above soil level. In some instances, it may even be higher depending on how well the soil drains. Add gypsum to the bottom of the hole to help break up any clay and turn it into useable soil for the plant. Again, using the rule of thirds for your planting mixture, mound the soil up around the rootball, but do not put material right up against the trunk. If you pile material up along the trunk/crown, you will suffocate your plant. For particularly bad drainage, add a drain channel in the bottom of the hole about 3 feet deep and filled with gravel.
- 3) If your plant is in a container, remove the rootball from the plastic pot. Try to rough up, or tease the roots loose by moving your hands up and down the root mass. If the root mass is potbound, use a knife or hand pruner to score the roots vertically 3-5 times, then use your hands to loosen the roots up a bit. Don't fear for the plant's health! Believe us when we say you are doing it a big favor as it will encourage new root growth to help your plant become established quicker.
- 4) Carefully place the rootball into the hole so that the top of the rootball is 1-2" above ground level, unless you have poor-draining soil as mentioned previously in step #2.
- 5) Backfill 2/3 the depth of the rootball with your blended soil mix created earlier.
- *For balled & burlap trees, cut the rope that wraps around the trunk. Remove only the top of the wire basket, leaving the bottom 2/3 on. **NEVER REMOVE THE WIRE CAGE COMPLETELY!** The plant needs the cage to help keep the soil packed around the roots. The roots will grow through the wire cage with no issues *

Loosen the burlap from around the trunk and fold it down around the hole. Remember to make sure the rootball is firmly set in the soil before untying the burlap and rope. For potted plants, simply slide them into the hole and backfill.

- 6) Continue to fill around the rootball with your blended soil mix and tamp the soil firmly and continue to add until it is roughly 3 inches from the top of the rootball.
- 7) Water the plant with a SuperThrive rooting hormone solution. See package for mix rate.
- 8) Complete filling with the blended soil, leaving the top 3 inches un-tamped. Makre sure there is no soil, mulch, rope, etc. next to the trunk as this will rot the bark, welcoming insects and disease. Using topsoil, make a bowl several inches away from the trunk to hold water for future irrigations.
- 9) Lay mulch 2-3" thick using wood chips, bark mulch, decorative stones, etc. and avoid building mulch up around the base of the plant. If it's built up, the heat produced by the mulch can burn the plant and rot the bark.
- 10) Guy and stake your trees for the first year after planting
- 11) In 3-4 weeks, add your fertilizer. There are many types of fertilizers available, but we usually like to use a slow-release granular fertilizer such as Jack's Classicote, or Osmocote. For other options, stop in store or talk to a nurseryman.

TIPS & TRICKS FOR A SUCCESSFUL FIRST YEAR

WATERING

Proper watering of plants after installation is perhaps the most important duty. The amount of water depends on the conditions of your area, but generally for the first year you should water 2-3 times per week if you haven't received at least 1 inch of rain. Most plants should not be soaked or kept soggy; Moist conditions are ample.

Some types of plants are a bit more on the dramatic end of things and will need to be watered fairly frequently throughout its lifespan, or require wetter conditions. For instances such as these, it's usually wise to invest in some soaker hose, or some type of irrigation system if you don't want to drag hoses/watering cans around.

Don't be concerned with a little wilt during the heat of the day, provided your plants are fresh looking again the next morning. It's important to let up on watering as much as possible as frosty mornings approach - this will encourage the new growth to harden off for the coming winter.

Signs of under-watering - the plant will 'flag', or show signs of distress such as drooping foliage or foliage that has turned yellow-brown and is crispy to the touch.

Signs of over-watering - the plant will show signs of distress such as foliage that's yellow-brown and has a leathery feel to it, molds growing on parts of the foliage, soggy soil.

FERTILIZING

Feeding your plants is something many people will overlook, but is vital to continued plant health. Plants vary from one type to another and require different types, or formulas of fertilizer. Generally, we use a rooting hormone at the time of installation to help prevent transplant shock and become established quicker. You can also use it as a general fertilizer for things that are very light feeders like lilac shrubs, or sedum.

The least care-intensive, but very effective method of fertilization is the use of a time-release granular fertilizer such as Jack's Classicote, or Osmocote that is applied 1-2 times per year. These types of fertilizers release nutrients over a period of 3-4 months.

PEST AND DISEASE CONTROL

The best way to ward off the onset of pests and diseases is to ensure you keep your plant healthy with good watering and fertilizing practices. Applying horticultutal oil (AKA dormant oil) in the early spring suffocates eggs that can turn into troublesome pests.

For insects, there is a broad range of insecticides, or organic oils etc., to control populations. Some are systemic and are taken up through the roots and into the plant to protect it from the inside-out, and some are used as a topical, or contact application. We can help you choose what's best for you!

For diseases, there is also a broad range of fungicides, bactericides, algaecides, etc., to prevent or combat different issues. We can help you choose what's best for your situation!


